| Original confirmation of registration of the school or university + 1 copy Original diplomas and certificates + 2 copies Motivation letter stating the objectives, duration of the study, diploma sought, future and professional plans – dated and signed + 1 copy Original confirmation of payment of the tuition and other fees + 1 copy Proof of sufficient private financial means to cover your living expenses during the studies: bank account statement of the last 3 months or balance confirmation letter + 1 copy |
| Alternatively: □ Letter of guarantee of a sponsor with residence in Switzerland + 1 copy or Letter of guarantee of a sponsor with residence in your home country + 1 copy □ Proof of solvability (for example: bank account statemens of the last 3 months or balance confirmation letter) + 1 copy □ 2 copies of valid passeport (page with photo only); if relevant: 2 copies of the Swiss residence permit - if the sponsor is a parent: birth certificate of the visa applicant + 1 copy |
| 2 copies of a resume (biographical data, schools attended, etc.) If available: original proof of language skills such as TOEFL or IELTS certificates; German, French or Italian language certificates + 2 copies Signed, dated and written commitment of the visa applicant to leave Switzerland after the completion of the studies + 1 copy |

The visa application will be transmitted to the competent cantonal immigration office for decision. The processing time may take a long time (8-12 weeks or longer). For information on the status of your application, please contact the Cantonal immigration authorities.
