For each semester, three candidates will be invited to spend between **three and five months** at the Institute located in the heart of international Geneva in order:

- → to further a personal research project
- → to interact with the faculty and postgraduate students of the Institute.

The programme is **fully-paid**:

- → travel, visa, insurance, accommodation costs covered by the Institute
- → participants receive a **monthly stipend** to compensate for the loss of income in the institution of origin and cover subsistence costs in Geneva.
