

Checklist for Schengen Visa: Student, staying in Switzerland up to 90 days

Please submit the documents in the exact order given below, please do not staple any document.		\boxtimes	
Vali	d national passport :		
0	Issued within the last 10 years and with at least 3 months validity after the scheduled return, with at least two blank pages. Handwritten passports and passports with observations regarding the front page (bio data) cannot be accepted.		
2 passport size pictures :			
0	White background, not older than 6 months (size 35 – 40 mm in width, not copied or scanned picture).

0	Completed and signed by the applicant, if applicable, authorization of third person.		
0	If the applicant is a minor: visa application signed twice by legal guardian/s and if applicable, authorization of third person. (Proof of custody of a minor child: divorce papers, death certificate etc.).		
Prev	vious passport/s :		
0	If any, bound together with rubber band, not stapled.		
Pers	sonal cover letter :		
0	Signed and dated by student, mentioning :		
	The reason for pursuing studies in Switzerland.		
	 Future plans: professional development intended by the student after finishing his/her studies in Switzerland. Explanation on how the student is going to benefit from his/her studies in the future. 		
0	Confirmation that student will leave Switzerland after the completion of the studies.		
Acc	Acceptance / confirmation / registration letter from the school, university, etc		
0	Proof of payment of the Swiss school/university fee, with relevant bank statement, if applicable.		
0	Proof of accommodation: evidence on where student is staying at during the entire time within the Schengen zone.		
Proof of academic degrees :			
0	English language certificates such as TOEFL or IELTS is mandatory. German, French or Italian language certificates if available.		
0	Curriculum Vitae.		
0	Travel Insurance: Please refer to the list of approved Indian travel insurances:

0	Minimum coverage of 30,000 Euro / 50,000 USD / 50,000 CHF per person.		
0	Coverage of all expenses which might arise in connection with repatriation for medical reasons, urgent medical attention and/or emergency hospital treatment.		
0	The insurance has to cover the entire stay in the Schengen territory.		
0	Applicants who wish to apply for a six months or one year multiple entry visa are not obliged to provide a 180 (365) day coverage. It is sufficient to submit an insurance policy covering the first journey.

Proof of financial status :		
	The documents of the applicant or the sponsoring person (parents, etc.), if no fellowship is granted, have to be originals, in A4 format, with stamp and signature of Bank.	
0	 Last 3 months salary slips & last 3 months salary bank account statements. Last 3 months personal bank account statements. Personal ITR (only ITR-V, Indian Income Tax Return Verification Form or Acknowledgement is accepted) If Self-Employed and/or company owner: Business registration certificate / GST Registration with annex A & B / Partnership Deed / Proof of proprietorship, or other proof of ownership. Last 3 months personal & business bank. Company's & personal ITR (only ITR-V, Indian Income Tax Return Verification Form or Acknowledgement is accepted) for the last 2 assessment years. If student or unemployed: Parents or legal guardians must provide their personal bank account statements for the last 3 months. Personal ITR (only ITR-V, Indian Income Tax Return Verification Form or Acknowledgement is accepted) for the last 2 assessment years along with a confirmation letter of financial support and a copy of their passports. 	
0	Clear photocopies of valid UK, USA, or CAN visas (if any). Passport: photocopy of the 1 st page (bio data) and last page	
0	In case of visa refusal by an Embassy or High Commission within the last 2 years: Submit refusal notice and/or a written explanation about the reasons of refusal	
0	Visa fee: • Free of charge.	

Please note that:

- The required documents have to be submitted with the visa application (no fax or e-mail to Embassy accepted).
- Only the documents mentioned on the checklist are accepted.
- The Embassy of Switzerland reserves the right to ask for additional documents and/or for a personal interview.

Information for Certificate of Identity (Col) and Identity Certificate (IC) holders:

Additionally required documents are:

- valid Residence Certificate (RC)
- valid Return Visa
