

## Visa for family reunion (type D)

The application has to be submitted **in person and by appointment** at the counter of the Consulate General of Switzerland in Valletta.

7	2 copies of a Swiss Identity document or Swiss resident permit of the family member living in Switzerland			
8	2 copies of the lease contract or ownership agreement of the family member living in Switzerland			
9	2 copies of the payslip or bank account statement of the family member living in Switzerland of the last three months

## Fees and procedure

The visa fee is € 90.00, to be paid in cash. This fee doesn't apply to the family member of a Swiss or EU/EFTA national.

The Swiss representation reserves the right to request further documentation if considered appropriate. Incomplete applications or received by mail are not accepted.

The application will be sent for decision to the competent cantonal authority. This Swiss representation will only be able to issue the visa after receiving authorization. Please note that the processing time can vary and is of **ca 10 weeks**.
