Mobile passport station 2024

The Team of the Embassy in Wellington is pleased to inform you that the mobile passport station for the registration of biometric data will be coming to Christchurch and Auckland on the following dates:

- **Christchurch: Wednesday, 09.10.2024 – Thursday, 10.10.2024**
Where: Rydges, 30 Latimer Square, Christchurch 8011
- **Auckland: Monday, 21.10.2024 (afternoon) – Thursday, 24.10.2024**
Where: Europe House, Auckland University of Technology, Level 16, 56 Wakefield Street, Auckland

IMPORTANT: Please **mention Mobile Station in Auckland or Christchurch** in the last field of the application under “remarks”, otherwise your request can’t be considered and you will receive the link for an appointment in Wellington instead.

→ Detailed information about the payment process, required documents and how to make an appointment will be sent out once your online application has been checked. The processing may take several weeks. No appointments will be made by telephone. **Please be patient until you receive an e-mail from the Embassy with further instructions and do not contact us additionally by e-mail / telephone concerning your application for the mobile passport station.**

The deadline to apply online is Sunday, 18.08.2024

Please note that places are limited and submitting your application within the deadline does not automatically guarantee a place. Appointments are allocated on a “**first-come, first-served basis**”.

If you intend on travelling to Wellington in the near future, please make an appointment to have your biometric data taken at the Embassy.

General information

As a Swiss citizen you do not lose your nationality when your Swiss passport expires. Your nationality is granted to you by being registered at your place of origin in Switzerland. This registration entitles you to a Swiss passport whenever you require one. However, since 2010 biometric data has to be registered (photo, fingerprints and signature) in order to obtain a new Swiss travel document. The data can only be collected at a Cantonal passport office in Switzerland or at a Swiss representation abroad. The competent Swiss passport office for your place of residence is located in Wellington.

It is also an option to have your biometric data registered during your next visit to Switzerland. This still involves an online passport application that needs to be checked by the Embassy in Wellington. When completing the online application it is important that you let us know under the section “remarks” in which canton (see www.fedpol.admin.ch → Passport&Identity card → Swiss passport and identity card → passport office) you would like to have your biometric data registered.

Reminder: Please inform this Embassy about any changes of your contact details (such as email, telephone number, address) as well as to the civil status (including birth of children and name changes). Your civil status must be up to date for your application to be considered for the mobile passport station in Auckland or Christchurch.
