## Visa documentation for applicants living in Pakistan

Documents to be submitted by all applicants:		
1.	Visa application form	Schengen visa application form, duly completed and signed by the applicant
		In case of a minor applicant: form needs to be signed by all legal guardians
2.	Two passport photos	In colour, white background, not older than 6 months
3.	Passport	Valid passport, not older than 10 years:
		<ul> <li>must contain at least two empty pages and</li> <li>be valid for at least three months after travel has been completed</li> </ul>
		Any previous passports
4.	Medical insurance	Minimum coverage of EUR 30'000, for medical costs and medical repatriation, valid in all Schengen countries during the whole validity of the issued visa.
		Holders of diplomatic passports (all travel purposes) and official/service passports (official travel only) are exempt from providing insurance.
5.	Photocopies of:	Any previous Schengen visas, respectively information / refusal notice of the relevant Embassies concerning application stamps in the passport or negative decisions.
6.	Visa fee	Payable in cash in PKR as per information on the website of the Embassy
		The fee is non-refundable if the visa is not granted.
