Results: Raising 7 bridges over the Crnica river in Paraćin centre to increase the river discharge capacity and prevent flooding

- Installation of hydro-meteorological monitoring equipment in 7 new locations to improve early warning system in Užice and lead time for evacuation in case of floods
- DRR training for capacity building at local level

- Results: Development of Disaster Risk
 Information System DRIS) a new tool for comprehensive disaster risk management at local level
 - Disaster risk assessment and Protection Plans for 15 Municipalities
 - Smart board equipment for 17 municipalities
- KRAL Capacity building and training
 - Study of potential locations for hydrologic and meteorologic monitoring equipment to improve EWS in the West Morava River basin EVAC
 - Installation of hydrologic and meteorologic monitoring equipment in 5 new locations
 - Design of the early warning, informing and alarming system for Užice
 - Design and implementation of software solution as a support to EWS, and the pilot testing

Disaster Risk Financing and Insurance (DRFI) program Serbia **550,000 Euro** grant by State
Secretariat for Economic Affairs of the Swiss Confederation (SECO)

Objective: To strengthen the Government of Serbia's financial preparedness for disasters

Results: A contingent line of credit signed with the World Bank to be activated in case of disaster (CAT DDO): already used twice, in 2018 and 2019

- Fiscal risk unit established within Ministry of Finance
- Local-level DRFI plans developed for 3 pilot Local Self Governments

SECO and SDC have assigned additional 1.5 million Euro for the ongoing projects:
Modernisation of TENT B; Joint program for Roma and marginalized groups; Housing program for the vulnerable; selected small projects.
