



## TRANSIT VISA / AIRPORT TRANSIT

Information sheet for people travelling through Switzerland to another, non-Schengen State.

### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS AND GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- One (1) application form duly completed: in German, French, Italian, Spanish or English; online, by typewriter or in block letters with a blue or black pen; and personally signed by the applicant
- Signed passport, issued within ten (10) preceding years, valid at least three (3) months beyond the planned stay in the Schengen states and containing at least two (2) empty pages
- One (1) copy of the applicant's passport: pages 1–4; last page; all pages showing extension of validity; all pages with previously obtained visas
- Two (2) recent and identical, biometric passport-size pictures
- Visa application fee: EUR 60.-, children age 6 to 12: EUR 35.- (**TRY equivalence**)
- Original and one copy of a travel / health insurance; **minimum coverage EUR 30'000.- valid for all Schengen states** for the whole period of the intended stay. The insurance policy must cover the costs for repatriation in case of disease, urgent medical expenses and/or hospitalization.
- Minors travelling without their legal representative(s) must bring an authorization of their legal representative(s) legalized by a notary (original and copy)
- Flight reservation for the journey to final destination
- The transit passenger is not allowed to leave the transit area in the airport
- The transit passenger must submit the travel documents required for entry into the country of destination.

The Consulate General of Switzerland reserves the right to request additional documents and/or to summon the applicant for an interview.
