For all persons with Contract Type A

working in Switzerland

WHO IS INSURED?

Insured are all those persons who are employed under a **Contract Type A for FDFA** and whose activities to fulfil the Contract, or for training are carried out only in Switzerland.

WHAT IS INSURED?

(Collective Daily Allowance Insurance – Policy No. B46.0.101.030 with Allianz Suisse)

IN CASE OF ILLNESS

Daily Allowance

A daily allowance consisting of 80% of the relevant daily fees is paid from the 15th day onward for the length of the contract as agreed upon beforehand, but not longer than for 716 days. The maximum per diem fee that can be insured amounts to CHF 548 (corresponding to an annual amount of CHF 200,000)

Excluded are:

- 1) Illnesses and their consequences
 - which were already in existence at the start of the insurance coverage
 - which became discernable during the first 8 days from the beginning of, or following the conclusion of, insurance coverage, unless it can be medically certified that the illness began during the period covered by the insurance.
- 2) Dental illnesses
- 3) Pregnancy

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
