Notification to the Parties and Signatories to the Agreement Establishing the Agency for International Trade Information and Cooperation (AITIC) as an Intergovernmental Organisation, concluded in Geneva on 9 December 2002

I. Accession by the Republic of Cuba

On 27 February 2007, the Republic of Cuba deposited with the Swiss Government its instrument of accession to the Agreement Establishing the Agency for International Trade Information and Cooperation (AITIC) as an Intergovernmental Organisation, concluded in Geneva on 9 December 2002.

According to its article 17 paragraph 3, the Agreement will enter into force for the Republic of Cuba on the 30th day following the date on which the instrument has been deposited, i.e. on 29 March 2007.

II. Accession by the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago

On 28 February 2007, the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago deposited with the Swiss Government its instrument of accession to the Agreement Establishing the Agency for International Trade Information and Cooperation (AITIC) as an Intergovernmental Organisation, concluded in Geneva on 9 December 2002.

According to its article 17 paragraph 3, the Agreement will enter into force for the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago on the 30th day following the date on which the instrument has been deposited, i.e. on 30 March 2007.

The Swiss Federal Council makes the present notification in its capacity as depositary according to article 20 of the Agreement.
