RATIFICATION BY THE SUDAN

Based on Article XX of the Convention, the Democratic Republic of the Sudan has deposited with the Swiss Government, on October 26, 1982, its instrument of ratification of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora.

The Sudan has entered a reservation on the Species "Croco-dylus niloticus" classified in Appendix I.

In conformity with Article XXII, Paragraph 2, the Convention will come into force for the Democratic Republic of the Sudan on January 24, 1983.

II

AMENDMENT OF JUNE 22, 1979 TO THE CONVENTION

The Federal Department of Foreign Affairs informs the Signatory or Contracting States of the Convention that the following States, by depositing an instrument with the Swiss Government, have accepted the Amendment to Article XI, Paragraph 3, sub-paragraph (a), adopted at Bonn on June 22, 1979:

Jordan on September 15, 1982
South Africa on October 1st, 1982
Peru on October 6, 1982
Nepal on October 21, 1982

The Amendment shall enter into force for the Parties which shall have accepted it 60 days after two-thirds of the Parties shall have deposited an instrument of acceptance of the Amendment with the Depositary Government.

The present notification is addressed to the Governments of Signatory or Contracting States in conformity with Article XXV, Paragraph 2, of the Convention.
