



Visa for work (type D)

Procedure and list of documents

Kindly be advised that requests from applicants who intend to work in Switzerland for more than 120 days should be submitted directly by the future employer in Switzerland to the competent migration office.

Once the working permit has been approved, the applicant can contact the Swiss representation in order to obtain an entry visa.

The applicant needs to submit the following documents **by appointment** at the counter of the competent Swiss representation:

Doc. n°	Documents
1	Authorisation issued by the cantonal authority (with SIMIC number);
2	Valid passport , signed by the owner, with at least 2 free pages and 1 copy
3	Maltese residence permit and 1 copy
4	1 recent, passport-size color photograph , format 3,5 / 4 cm, with neutral background.

Fee

The visa fee is € 80.00, to be paid in cash.
